Cabin hygiene	All	Cabin kept clean and tidy with regular cleaning Cabin out-of-bounds to all except catering volunteers other than for medical emergency and access to key for toilets.	4	2	8
Toilets	All	Toilets kept clean and tidy with regular cleaning. Partly out of club control Only ladies toilet accessible.	4	2	8
Cross contamination	Players	Each player to use own boules and jack, which only they will touch during play. Sanitiser to be provided for rings and scoring pegs. Sanitising hand gel to be provided Verbal reminders at each session. Hand gel dispenser available and accessible	4	1	4
Risk of contact with infected person	All	Two metres social distancing maintained where practicable. Members should allow others adequate space when agreeing score and retrieving boules on finishing an end. Keep register of all present at the club on each occasion. Face masks optional. Decking arrangements: one way system. Signage plus verbal reminders at each session	4	3	12
Risk of contact with infection – surfaces etc.	All	Provision of hand gels. Regular cleaning of surfaces with anti-bacterial wipes/spray, and at start / end of each session. Regular use of hand gels and instructed not to touch face with unwashed hands. Post session wipe down of items, use of gloves and washing/sanitizing of hands by club representative after contact.	4	2	8
